Delivery	Length	Notes
Session 1: Preparing to Implement Al's Pals		
Virtual or On-Site Training	1 Day	In the first of two 6-hour sessions, collaborative training supports teachers' understanding of social—emotional learning and its important role in childhood development. Throughout the workshop, teachers meaningfully interact, discuss, and reflect on how to best create inclusive environments for children's social—emotional learning. Teachers evaluate strategies that foster protective factors and examine how to further develop their own guidance skills.
Session 2: Implementing Al's Pals		
Virtual or On-Site Training	1 Day	In the second part of the two-day training, teachers continue to delve into the important skills that promote protective factors. Throughout the workshop, teachers' own feelings and biases are addressed and examined. Teachers explore the Al's Pals lessons, materials, and core concepts. Teachers will collaboratively practice the Al's Pals lessons and debrief on how to best engage every child in a purposeful, positive social-emotional learning experience. Specific attention is given to how social-emotional learning can promote equity among young children.
Continuing Professional Development: Al's Pals Refresher		
Virtual or On-Site Training	1 Day	In this course, experienced Al's Pals teachers will collaborate to review important, updated social—emotional learning skills and strategies to best meet the needs of children in today's classroom. Participants will explore the new Al's Pals materials and practice implementing them.
