What You Do

1. Recite the following chant.

Bubble, bubble, letter-sound trouble! Let's think of words on the double!

Can you think of words that start with the [/s/] sound?

- Ask the children to think of words that start with the given sound.
- Make a list of the words the children generate.

- Ask the children to think of words
 that fit into a specific category,
 e.g., "Can you think of foods that
 start with the /b/ sound?"
- Invite the children to draw pictures of the words generated during the activity.
- For children who need support, hold up a letter card and encourage the children to identify the name of the letter and its sound before sharing words.
