Quorum is free to all licensed DC early education providers until June 2025. All DC providers should register through their employer and will receive a free personalized membership account.

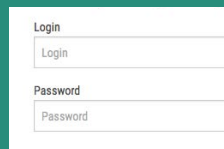


OSSE Required Health and Safety Training Topics	Quorum Courses that meet Requirements (6 courses)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Prevention and control of infectious diseases, including immunization Administration of medication, consistent with standards for parental or guardian consent 	<p>Cut the Cooties: Communicable Disease Prevention (2 hours)</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Prevention of sudden infant death syndrome and use of safe sleep practices, if serving infants/toddlers 	<p>Safe Sleep & Sweet Dreams for Infants (2 hours)</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Prevention of and response to emergencies due to food and allergic reactions 	<p>From Food to Physical Activity (4 hours)</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Child abuse and neglect, prevention, detection and reporting Prevention of shaken baby syndrome and abusive head trauma, as applicable 	<p>Understanding Child Abuse & Prevention (3 hours)</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Building and physical premises safety, including identification of and protection from hazards that can cause bodily injury such as electrical hazards, bodies of water, and vehicular traffic Emergency preparation and response planning for emergencies resulting from a natural disaster or a human-caused event Poison prevention, including the handling and storage of hazardous materials and the appropriate disposal of bio contaminants 	<p>Keeping Our Children Safe: Planning Ahead and Being Prepared (4 hours)</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Transportation safety 	<p>Traveling with Precious Cargo (3 hours) <i>Only required if transporting children</i></p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> First aid and CPR 	<p>Must be completed at an in-person training See DCcpdis.org for list of trainings</p>
<p>*Developmentally appropriate programming for infants, toddlers, preschool, and/or school-age children, as applicable</p>	<p>Quorum offers multiple courses for this topic See DCcpdis.org for list of trainings</p>

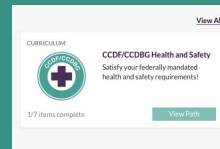

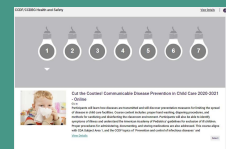
Step 1: Select student login
