



## Teacher Satisfaction and Child Outcomes Elevated

When assessment and instructional resources are seamlessly integrated and used with assessment data to inform instruction, the combined solution is more impactful than an assessment solution alone. How do we know? We compared survey results of educators using Teaching Strategies' leading assessment tool *GOLD*® alone with those of educators using *GOLD*® in conjunction with the digital instructional resources in *The Creative Curriculum*® Cloud ("the Cloud"), including time-saving digital planning tools and family engagement resources. The compelling results speak for themselves.

### Cloud Resources Increase Teacher Satisfaction

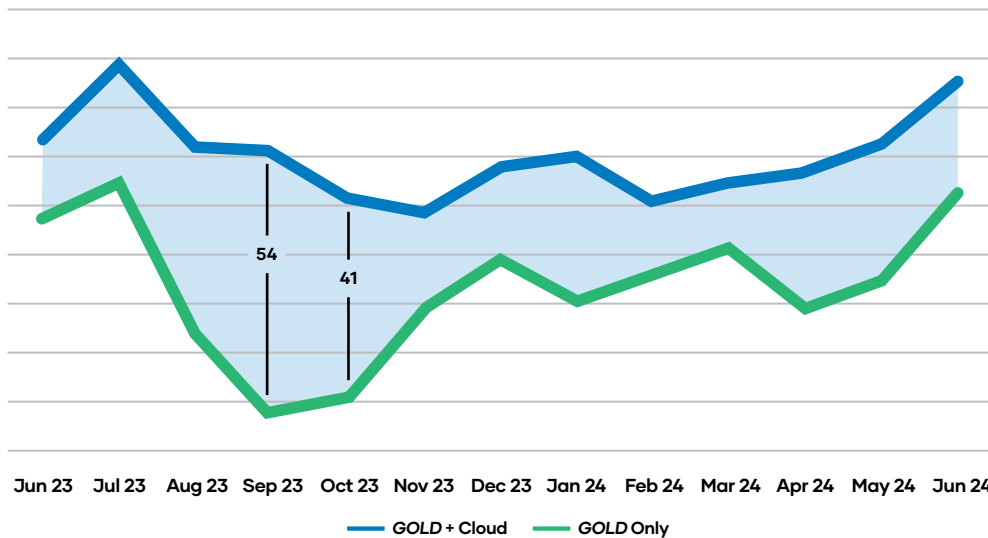
The NPS\* survey question was administered monthly, yielding a monthly NPS\* score—a proxy for educators' satisfaction with Teaching Strategies and its solutions.

The chart below shows the **increased satisfaction** (as measured by NPS) **among educators using both *GOLD*® assessment and the Cloud** digital instructional resources compared to those using *GOLD*® assessment alone.

#### \*What is NPS?

The Net Promoter Score (NPS) is a very commonly used **measure of customer satisfaction and loyalty** based on customers' willingness to recommend the company/product. Customers consistently respond using a prescribed rating scale and NPS scores are consistently calculated using a prescribed formula.

\*\* Note: Historically, NPS ratings dip in Sept./Oct. due to the increased local demands during checkpoint testing periods. Results suggest, however, that the Cloud's instructional resources and digital tools provided additional support to teachers at this critical time that translated into significantly higher NPS ratings.

## Supporting Teachers With Time-Saving Tools

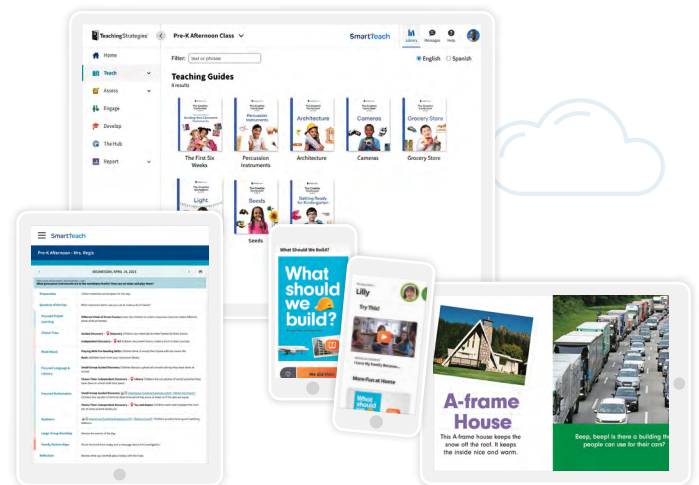
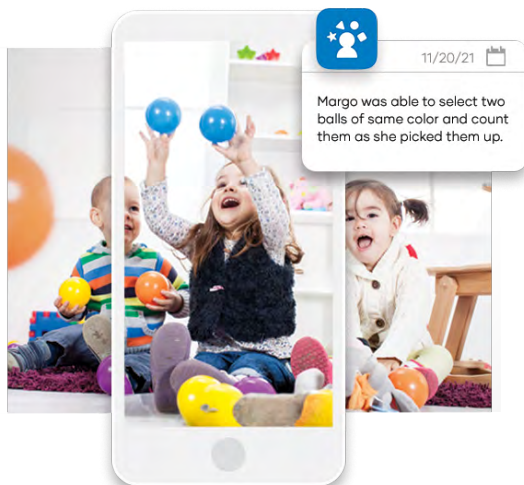
